- CPCWHS1001 Prepare to work safely in the construction industry (White Card)

First Aid - You must collect a first aid book, complete the theory assessment prior to the face-to-face practical training day and submit on the day of training.

RSA/RCG - You do not need to be 18 years or older to complete the course, however, it is the minimum legal age required to use the certification. You must bring photo identification on the day of training. Once training and assessment is completed, you must apply to the regulatory body for your license.

Safe Food Handling - Enclosed shoes and long pants must be worn. Hair should be tied back neatly and jewelry removed. The entire day of training is required.

White Card - Enclosed shoes must be worn. You must bring 100 points of original ID on the day of training. Refer to www.safework.nsw.gov.au/licences-and-registrations/licences/evidence-of-identity
